SECURITY TRACKING OF OFFICE PROP

STOP Tag

Stop tags are tamper-proof security plates with a barcode and indelible tattoo. The tags are pre-printed with information that ownership of the property is permanently monitored, and explains that a police traceable tattoo is beneath the plate. Once applied to a piece of property it takes approximately 800 lbs. of pressure to remove the tag. If the tag is successfully removed, it leaves a 'tattoo' on the asset with the words 'Stohen Property' and a telephone number. In the event of a lose, the police can easily identify recovered property and return it to its rightful owner. These tags are ideal for equipment that cannot be cabled down, or may be in a location that cannot be adequately secured. Laptops, projectors and small or easily portable property are excellent candidates for STOP Tags.
